ABOUT SARAH LAWRENCE'S PROGRAMS

THE MASTER OF SCIENCE IN DANCE/MOVEMENT THERAPY PROGRAM is based on the empirically supported premise that the body and mind are interconnected and interact in health and illness. Body movement provides both a means of assessment and a mode of intervention for dance/movement therapists, working with individuals or with groups, in the treatment of developmental, medical, social, physical, or psychological impairments.

THE JOAN H. MARKS GRADUATE PROGRAM IN HUMAN GENETICS was the first of its kind in the United States. It remains the largest graduate program in genetic counseling in the world. Integrating education, healthcare, and humanism, this celebrated program prepares genetic counselors to work in a growing, dynamic field.

THE MASTER OF ARTS PROGRAM IN WOMEN'S HISTORY was the country's first graduate degree program in women's history. The program immerses students in a combination of historical studies, feminist theory, and gender studies, drawing upon and actively supporting an ongoing legacy of activism regarding social and political concerns related to women and gender.
