Summer 2017 Parking Plans

As you know, we have been working to finalize plans to construct an additional 69 parking spaces on campus. These new spaces are being created to help offset approximately 90 spaces in Andrews Lot that will be displaced by the construction of the Barbara Walters Campus Center.

Construction for these new parking spaces will commence on June 5 and run through approximately August 25. I apologize for any inconvenience that this construction will create, and assure you that we are taking steps to mitigate the impact on our community and our visitors this summer.

As noted on map and described further below, five existing parking areas will be under construction and unavailable for use during the construction period:

Area 1 (Rear of Andrews Lot) – The rear of Andrews lot (past the crosswalk) will be closed to create an extension that will accommodate 14 new spaces. However, the remaining spaces in Andrews lot will be available for parking and the 14 College vans currently assigned to this lot will be permanently relocated to Kober lot.

Area 2 (Morrill House) – The Morrill House parking lot will be closed to support the formalization of 17 spaces at this location. Please note that the nearby Marshall Field parking lot will remain open through the summer.

Area 3 (Lynd House) – The parking lot behind Lynd House will be closed to facilitate the addition of 11 new parking spaces in this lot.

Area 4 (Swinford House) – The Swinford House parking lot will be closed to support the formalization of 17 parking spaces at this location. Please note that the Mead Way lot (across from Westlands gate) will remain open through the summer, though several of these spaces will be reserved for visiting prospective students and their families.

Area 5 (Science Center/North) – The Science Center/North lot will be closed to support a full reconfiguration of this area that will result in the creation of 10 additional parking spaces.

Because of the closure of these parking areas, we are recommending the use of the Kober parking lot through the summer. To lessen the inconvenience, a shuttle van will run to and from Kober Parking lot for the duration of the construction period, with drop-offs first at Westlands Gate and then at North Gate and pick-ups in reverse. This shuttle will run in continuous loops as follows:

Monday to Thursday: 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Friday:

8 a.m. to 10 a.m. 12:30 p.m. to 1 p.m. 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

As always, medical transport shuttles will run as needed throughout the summer.

Thank you for your continued support as we progress towards construction of the Barbara Walters Campus Center.
