As we near the mid-point of the semester, it is exciting to think ahead to the opening of the Barbara Walters Campus Center this fall.

As part of the campus center project, the crosswalks and traffic signal at Kimball Avenue and Glen Washington road will be upgraded. This work will increase the number of crosswalks and provide separate traffic signals at this intersection for vehicles on Glen Washington Road. These improvements will increase the safety for pedestrians and drivers alike.

The initial phase of this work will begin on Monday, March 4, and require temporary sidewalk closures at this intersection across from the new campus center. Construction barriers and signage will be posted during these times. I ask everyone to be extra watchful and cautious with respect to the changed pedestrian conditions in this area.

In closing, I'd like to announce that the campus center is completely water tight and that we have shifted our focus to the building's interior features and design. In addition, the outdoor marble theatre is expected to open later this month, once the newly laid grass sod has taken hold.
