Dear Sarah Lawrence Community:

I hope everyone had an enjoyable break. I am writing to update you on the next steps for the Barbara Walters Campus Center project.

As you may have noticed, we have nearly completed the new driveway to the Andrews parking lot, and it will be available beginning Wednesday, March 28. At the same time, we will be closing the existing entrance to Andrews parking lot and extending the project fencing closer to the Library. For your safety, we ask that all pedestrians walk on the PAC side of Glen Washington Road at all times.

With the extension of the project fencing, the current walking path on Andrews Lawn will be closed. Access to Andrews Court, Andrews House, and Andrews Annex will now be available via a temporary walkway constructed between Andrews parking lot and Andrews Courts (across from Slonim House). We ask that drivers and pedestrians alike use caution and remain alert as we all get accustomed to the new driveway and pedestrian paths from Kimball Avenue. The excavation of the project site, which will include chipping of bedrock, begins on Thursday, March 29 and will continue for approximately eight weeks. We are aware that this phase of the project will be among the most disruptive from a noise perspective; therefore, we will be limiting the hours of rock-chipping between 8 am and 6 pm weekdays. Our goal is to complete this portion of the project as quickly as possible, and I appreciate your understanding of the related noise disturbances.

As always, please let me know if you should have any questions, and I will continue to keep you updated as we progress with the excavation of the project site.
