

Commencement Speaker DOUGLAS BRINKLEY

Douglas Brinkley is the Katherine Tsanoff Brown Chair in Humanities and Professor of History at Rice University; a frequent commentator on CBS, CNN, and MSNBC; and a contributing editor at *Vanity Fair*. He works in many capacities in the world of public history, including boards, museums, colleges, and historical societies. *The Chicago Tribune* dubbed Brinkley "America's new past master," and the New-York Historical Society has chosen him as their official U.S. Presidential Historian.

Brinkley's book *Cronkite* won the Sperber Prize while *The Great Deluge: Hurricane Katrina, New Orleans, and the Mississippi Gulf Coast* received the Robert F. Kennedy Book Award. He won a Grammy Award for *Presidential Suite* and has received seven honorary doctorates in American studies. His two-volume annotated *The Nixon Tapes* recently won the Arthur S. Link-Warren F. Kuehl Prize. His most recent book, *American Moonshot: John F. Kennedy and the Great Space Race,* was a *New York Times* bestseller. Brinkley's forthcoming book, *Silent Spring Revolution: John F. Kennedy, Rachel Carson, Lyndon Johnson, Richard Nixon, and the Great Environmental Awakening,* will be published by HarperCollins in November 2022.

Brinkley is a member of the Century Association, Council of Foreign Relations, and the James Madison Council of the Library of Congress. He lives in Austin, Texas, with his wife and three children.

Honorary Degree Recipient JENNIFER FINNEY BOYLAN

Jennifer Finney Boylan is the author of 18 books and the inaugural Anna Quindlen Writer in Residence at Barnard College of Columbia University. Her 2003 memoir, *She's Not There: A Life in Two Genders* (Broadway/ Doubleday/Random House), was the first bestselling work by a transgender American. In addition to her work as a novelist, memoirist, and short story writer, she is a nationally known advocate for human rights.

Jennifer serves on the Board of Trustees of PEN America, the nonprofit advocating for authors, readers, and freedom of expression. From 2011 to 2018 she was on the Board of Directors of GLAAD, serving as co-chair from 2013 to 2017. She also is a member of the faculty of the Bread Loaf Writers' Conference of Middlebury College and the Sirenland Writers' Conference in Positano, Italy.

For many years she was a contributing opinion writer for *The New York Times*. She has also been a member of the Board of Trustees of the Kinsey Institute for Research on Sex, Gender, and Reproduction.

Jennifer's most recent book is the memoir *Good Boy: My Life in Seven Dogs*, published by Celadon/Macmillan in April 2020. Her next book project is the novel *Mad Honey*, co-authored with Jodi Picoult, slated for publication in 2022 by Ballantine/Random House. She has appeared on *The Oprah Winfrey Show* on four occasions; *Live with Larry King* twice; the *Today Show*, the *Barbara Walters Special*, and NPR's *Marketplace* and *Talk of the Nation*; she has also been the subject of documentaries on CBS News' *48 Hours* and The History Channel. She served as an adviser to the television series *Transparent*.

Jennifer lives in New York City and in Belgrade Lakes, Maine, with her wife, Deedie. They have a son, Sean, and a daughter, Zai.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME CODE

The custom of wearing academic dress stems from the Middle Ages when scholars were also clerics and wore the costumes of their monastic orders. Significant parts of academic dress are the gown, the hood, and the cap. Each has a particular significance and is worn in accordance with standards established by the Academic Costume Code of the American Council on Education.

PRESIDENTIAL REGALIA

The president has always been the focal point of a college or university commencement. For this reason, it is acceptable that they wear a distinctive gown unique to the institution over which they preside. The unique feature of a presidential gown is the addition of the fourth chevron to each sleeve. This honor is granted only to one who holds the rank of president or chancellor of an academic institution.

GOWNS

The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve, open at the wrist. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square-cut, and the front part has an arc cut away. The gown is supplied with fasteners so that it may be worn open or closed.

HOODS

Sarah Lawrence College uses hoods for the master's degree, which are three and a half feet in length. Hoods are lined with the official colors of the College, green and white. The colors of the trimmings of the hoods are associated with different subject matters, as follows, conferred at Sarah Lawrence College:


